WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant is to utilize funds to decrease liability through the purchase of supplies and materials, and

WHEREAS, staff will be purchasing lifejackets, and

WHEREAS, funds are available from grant funds to be received in the Forest Preserve General Fund #130, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Forest Preserve Commission of Rock Island County, Rock Island, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. An emergency exists as outlined above.

SECTION 3. An amount of \$500.00 be transferred from the above described revenue changes in the General Fund #130 to the following:


